REGULATIONS:

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the Dean's International Doctoral Scholarships (FMHS).
2. Up to three Scholarships will be awarded annually, each for a period of up to three years. The Scholarships will include compulsory fees and health insurance (see Notes ii and iii), plus up to \$29,500 in the first year and up to the \$26,500 per annum in subsequent years. A further six months scholarship funding, subject to Scholarship Sub-committee approval, may be available (see Note v).
3. The Scholarships will be awarded to students who have paid the fees, or arranged to pay the fees, for full-time enrolment in a PhD degree in the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences at The University of Auckland.
4. The Scholarships are tenable only by students who are neither citizens nor permanent residents of New Zealand or Australia, and comply with the requirements of the domestic fees policy for PhD students.
5. Selection will be based on academic merit (measured by the grade point average assessed over the applicant's two most recent years of equivalent full-time study), quality of the applicant's research proposal and endorsements by the proposed supervisor and Head of School.
6. The Scholarships will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising the Dean (or nominee), the Associate Dean (Postgraduate), and the International Development Manager, from the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences, and a representative from the Board of Graduate Studies.
7. The Scholarships will consist of a fortnightly stipend, an annual tuition fees credit, a one-off relocation grant, health insurance and an annual allowance for travel. The relocation grant will be paid on receipt of evidence of costs associated with relocation to commence the doctorate.
8. The Scholarships may be held with any other study award or grant where the regulations for that award or grant permit and where The University of Auckland Council so approves. If the Scholarship recipient is also awarded a University of Auckland Doctoral Scholarship or a New Zealand International Doctoral Research Scholarship, the emolument for the Dean's International Doctoral Scholarship (FMHS) will be reduced to limit the co-tenured total to \$35,000.
9. To comply with the full-time study requirement in Regulation 3, the amount of additional and paid work a Scholar may undertake either inside or outside the University shall not exceed a total of 500 hours per year.
10. The University of Auckland Council, in consultation with the Dean of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences, has the power to terminate or suspend a Scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a Scholar from the Board of Graduate Studies.
11. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if in any year there are insufficient candidates of sufficient merit.
12. The University of Auckland has the power to amend or vary these Regulations, in consultation with the Dean of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences, provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.
13. Applications must be made on the Scholarships Office application form available from the Scholarships Office website. The completed application form must be submitted to the Associate Dean (Postgraduate) of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences by 30 April. Applicants must also complete and submit a doctoral Expression of Interest (EOI) online.

Notes:

- (i) *Students who have been offered a scholarship must meet all requirements for admission into the PhD programme in order to take up the scholarship offer.*
- (ii) *Tuition/Compulsory fees are only those related to the relevant programme of study, plus Student Services Fee and Building Levy.*
- (iii) *The award of the Scholarship is conditional upon the ability of The University of Auckland and the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences to provide adequate supervision and resources.*
- (iv) *A further 6 months scholarship funding may be available to students who are unable to complete in three years due to the exigencies of research.*
- (v) *Students are required to take up their scholarship within five months of it being awarded. The latest possible date for registration is 1 November in the year of the award.*
- (vi) *Each year recipients of the Dean's International Doctoral Scholarship (FMHS) must sign a statutory declaration that, in the previous academic year, they have complied with the regulations for the Scholarship and that they give an undertaking that, in the current academic year, they will notify the University of any change in their enrolment status. The University of Auckland may, in the event it can be established that a recipient of a Dean's International Scholarship (FMHS) is not complying with these regulations, terminate the Scholarship and require repayment of the funds received from the date of the breach.*

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Application is made to the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences' Associate Dean (Postgraduate) using the Scholarships Office application form. Applicants must also complete and submit a doctoral Expression of Interest (EOI) online.

A Selection Committee assesses the applications

Shortlisted applicants will be required to undergo an interview either in person or through video conference facilities

The Scholarships are awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Selection Committee
